Purpose of the Community Resilience Indicator

Generate
a national level picture
of resilience
of forest-dependent
communities

Community

People residing in a geographic territory.
The community has a particular history,
specific demographic patterns
and houses industries and organizations.

Community members interact for multiple purposes, e.g.,
political, economic and social, and can mobilize
community resources to take collective action
for the benefit of individuals and/or the community.

Towns are typical communities. Rural communities can
extend beyond the city limits or may be unincorporated.

Larger cities may be comprised of several communities.

Forest communities are those that are adjacent to forests or
are dependent on forest-based industries.
